Pancheshwar: Approximately 30 km from Champawat; 50 km from Tanakpur; about 200 km from Pantnagar Airport.

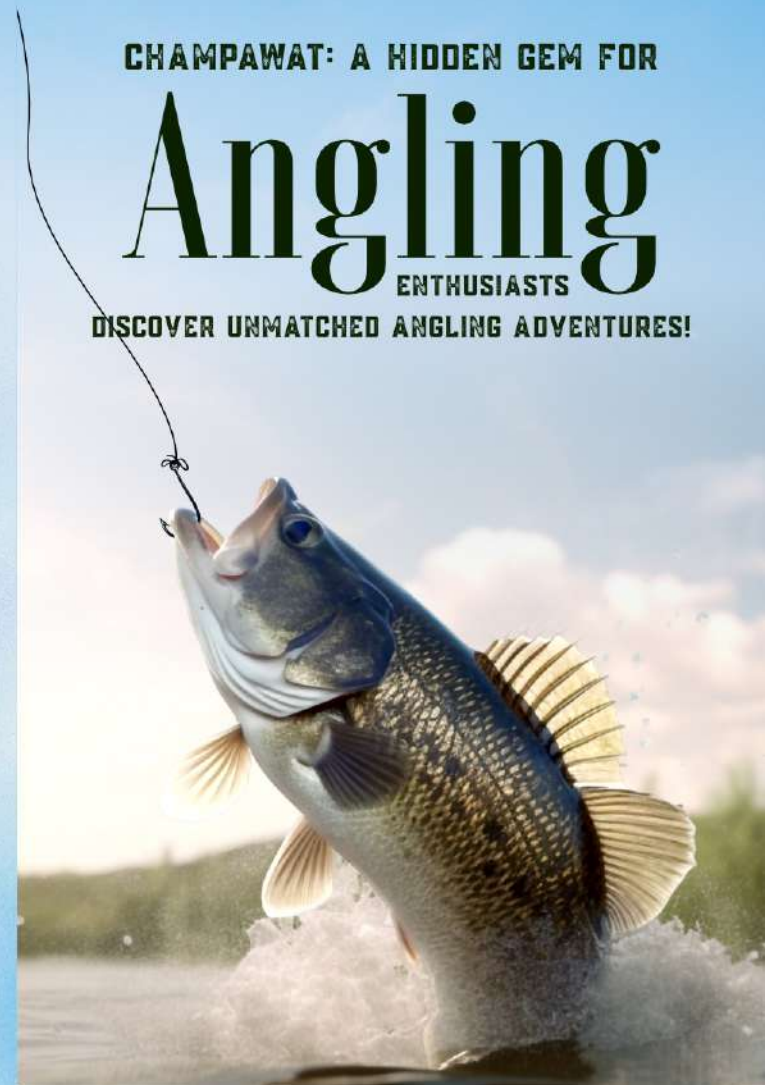

Gear Up: Equip yourself with sturdy tackle to challenge the formidable Mahseer and Goonch.

Sustainable Practices: Practice catch-and-release to preserve Champawat's aquatic biodiversity.

Local Expertise: Engage local guides for invaluable insights into prime fishing spots and techniques.

ANGLING PERMITS & GUIDELINES

A permit is mandatory for angling in Champawat and can be obtained from the *Fisheries Department* via local *Yuvak Mangal Dal / Mahila Mangal Dal*.

- **Catch-and-Release:** Encouraged to maintain fish populations.
- **Designated Beats:** Fishing is permitted only in notified areas to ensure sustainability.
- **Respect Local Customs & Environment:** Engage responsibly with the community and natural surroundings.

BEST SEASONS FOR ANGLING

Post-Monsoon (Sep-Nov): Ideal water levels and heightened fish activity.

Pre-Summer (Mar-June): Clear waters enhance the angling experience.
