



## ADVENTURE & LEISURE ACTIVITIES IN CHAMPAWAT



Angling in Uttarakhand is a popular activity that attracts tourists from all over the world. The state is home to some of the most beautiful rivers and streams that are teeming with a variety of fish species, including trout, mahseer, and catfish. Nandhaur Wildlife Sanctuary was established in 2012 within the Terai Arc Landscape, which spans from Uttarakhand in India to Nepal. It is the Uttarakhand region's tiger reserve with the highest tiger population density. The Wildlife Institute of India recognized Nandhaur as one of the three tiger-sustaining habitats in 2004. The sanctuary's sal forest is home to 25 mammal species, 250 birds, 15 reptiles, and 20 fish, including Asian elephants, leopards, tigers, and sloth bears. The sanctuary offers unspoiled terrain, forests, trails, and landscapes, making it an ideal destination for nature and wildlife enthusiasts with safari facilities.







Leisure Activities



Enjoy the tranquil beauty of nature by leisurely boating at Shyamlatal and KoliDhek Lake in Champawat. Shyamlatal is a natural lake that offers waters with the breathtaking surroundings. Koli Dhek Lake is an artificial lake. Both lakes spread over 1.5 sq.km and offer multiple options to explore boating next to a scenic dense forest backdrop. By renting a paddleboat or rowboat, you can explore the peaceful surroundings and observe exotic birds in their natural habitat. You can flee the bustle of the city and immerse yourself in the tranquilly of nature thanks to the lush pastures that surround the lake.



Abbott Mount, Shyamlatal, and Tanakpur are home to a plethora of avian species thanks to their varied climate and topography. Abbott Mount at 6400 ft is an ideal location for bird watchers to observe an array of birds, including the Himalayan Monal and the Black Francolin. Spring and summers are best for birdwatching at Abbott Mount. Tanakpur, on the other hand, is home to migratory birds in winters. In Shyamlatal, you can find egrets, cranes, storks, and kingfishers among other birds. Visit in the early morning or late afternoon if you want to see birds at their most active.



Discover the enchanting world of butterflies at Shyamlatal, a natural lake in Champawat surrounded by dense forests. Shyamlatal is a butterfly observer's paradise, as it is home to more than 65 species of butterflies. From October to March, the cool and dry climate is ideal for spotting beautiful butterflies like the Striped Tiger, Himalayan Brimstone, and Common Mormon etc. In addition to butterflies, visitors can observe birds and small mammals. The trails surrounding the lake offer spectacular views and are ideal for hiking and picnicking. Connect with nature in its purest form while observing butterflies at Shyamlatal.
